## BLACK LIBERATION PRISONER

*imprisoned since 1971*



**Jalil Muntaqim** joined the Black Panther Party at 18. Less than 2 months before his 20th birthday, he and Albert Nuh Washington were captured in a midnight shootout with San Francisco police. He was subsequently charged with a host of revolutionary activities including the assassination of two police in NYC. It is for this that he is currently serving a 25 to life sentence in New York State. He and his co-defendants, Albert Nuh Washington (RIP) and Herman Bell are known as the New York 3. He was also implicated in the San Francisco 8 case, and pled guilty to a lesser offense. Jalil has been repeatedly denied parole, but he will not relent. He writes tirelessly on current issues relating to the black liberation struggle, and has published many visionary books and articles.
